

Dr. Carmil Azran is a clinical pharmacist specializing in bariatric surgery.

She received her Pharm.D degree at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). Following her graduation and residency worked a clinical pharmacist at the Neurological department at UCSF. Upon her arrival to Israel, she developed Clinical Pharmacy at Herzliya Medical Center, a private hospital that is one of the top hospitals to perform bariatric surgery in Israel.

Dr. Azran increased awareness in Israel to the problem of drug therapy and nutritional deficiencies post bariatric surgery by taking part in writing several Israeli guidelines, teaching students and other health-care providers, presenting at conferences, and publishing on the subject of drug therapy in general and drug therapy post bariatric surgery specifically. Dr. Azran also took part in writing the 2020 EAES guidelines and 2017 EASO guidelines.

Her interest in nutritional deficiencies led her to take part in developing Bariatric vitamins in Israel called BariMIL that are sold in most HMOs in Israel.

Currently, she is the Director of Medical Technology department at Maccabi Healthcare Services HMO, and still holds a clinic for patients before and after bariatric surgery.
