

Prof (Dr) Sandeep Aggarwal completed medical school and surgical residency from All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi. He did a 1-year fellowship at Mount Sinai School of Medicine, New York, USA. He is a Commonwealth Fellow, UK and is currently Professor of Surgery at AIIMS, New Delhi. He is an accomplished laparoscopic and bariatric surgeon and has developed a robust obesity surgery program at AIIMS, the first public funded Institution in India to do so. Since then he has operated more than 1000 morbidly obese patients. He has established a 2-year fellowship in Bariatric Surgery at AIIMS.

Dr Aggarwal is the Founder President of Foundation for Obesity Research and Metabolic Surgery and is an executive council member of Obesity and Metabolic Surgery Society of India (OSSSI) and IAGES. He is a member of AIIMS Institutional Ethics Committee for post-graduate research. He has authored numerous book chapters and published more than 90 research papers. Dr Aggarwal is the Section editor of an internationally acclaimed book on Bariatric Surgery published by Springer, UK. His research interests include NAFLD and GERD related to bariatric surgery.
