Dr. Juan Pujol Rafols is currently head of the general and digestive surgery unit at the Mi Tres Torres clinic in Barcelona and coordinator of the obesity and metabolic surgery unit (UCOM). He is a collaborating lecturer at the Cardenal Herrera University (CEU).

Recognised as an Expert in Bariatric and Metabolic Surgery by the Spanish Society of Obesity Surgery of which he is one of the founding members. In 2013 he received the World Society for Obesity Surgery Award for his professional career.

He has actively participated in many scientific events related to bariatric and metabolic surgery, among others he has been chairman of the 5th European Congress of IFSO, the 14th national congress SECO, member of the organizing committee of the 8th IFSO World Congress, the 5th International Symposium on Laparoscopic Surgery or the 17th International Congress on Obesity Surgery.

Author and co-author of relevant scientific articles published in journals such as "SOARD", "Obesity Surgery" or "Journal of GI Surgery" and contributor to chapters and books on the subject of Bariatric and Metabolic surgery.

He is head of the Communication and Development Committee of the European Society for Obesity Surgery and member of the Scientific Research Committee of the World Society for Obesity Surgery (IFSO).
