

Dr. Rui Ribeiro is the Coordinator of the “Metabolic Unit “ and “General Surgery Department” in Clínica de Santo António – Lusíadas.

He has experience in laparoscopic surgery mainly metabolic surgery techniques, both primary and revisional cases.

He was President of the SPCO for 6 years, now President of the General Assembly.

He is now member of the IFSO-EC Information and Development Committee, member of the HTC and “Chair of the International executive affairs” of the same Association.

Member of the Faculty of the CCMJU (training center in Caceres, Spain), Ircad (Strasbourg - France) and Hamburg Surgical Institute (J&J).

He is author of several scientific papers and coauthor of a set of cooperative scientific studies with impact on metabolic surgery.

He was the first proponent of the “diverted OAGB” or “Long pouch gastric bypass” as a bariatric technique for patients with gastroesophageal reflux issues previously to the metabolic intervention.

His research focuses about new surgical techniques like MGB-OAGB, SASI and Sleeve-Nissen.
